At the top of the PE: Current Status: Positive PASRR Eligibility

Section C of the PE may look like this:

C0500.	Inpatient Psychiatric Treatment	Has this individual experienced a psychiatric treatment more intensive than outpatient care more than once in the past 2 years? <input type="radio"/> No
C0600.	Disruption to normal living situation	Has this individual experienced a significant disruption to their normal living situation requiring supportive services (e.g. residential or respite services) in the last two years due to mental illness? <input type="radio"/> No
C0700.	Intervention by Law Enforcement	Has the individual experienced intervention by law enforcement, protective services agencies or other housing officials in the last two years due to mental illness? (i.e. evicted, arrested, charged or convicted of a crime) <input type="radio"/> No
C0800.	Based on the QMHP assessment, does the individual meet the PASRR definition of mental illness?	<input checked="" type="radio"/> Yes
Specialized Services Determination/Recommendations		

- C0800 should be "No" if the answers to questions C0500, 600 and 700 are "No".
- This is one example of a "false" positive.
- The LA should provide instructions on what type of PL1 to enter when you call them to attend the IDT and they indicate the individual has a "false" positive PE and is not really eligible for PASRR and doesn't need an IDT.
