# What is iQIES?

iQIES is an internet-based system that will be used for all submissions and communications to and from CMS

This includes MDS submissions, surveys, and certifications

#### **Timeline**

 CMS is transitioning to iQIES in early 2023

 Impacts MDS Transmission, Patient Assessments, and CASPER reports  Registration is now open for all regions

 No official start date yet but CMS confirmed that it will be sometime in early 2023





# Why the change?

- Increased Federal Security Mandates
  - Remote Identify Proofing
  - Secure identity management provided by CMS through HARP
- CMS wants to know who is accessing PHI information
- CMS wants to know what PHI they are accessing
- CMS wants to know who the Provider Security Official (PSO) will be in your organization





Follow these steps to register your Provider Security Official (PSO):


1. Identify at least one individual who will be the Provider Security Official (PSO).

2. Each individual will need to register for iQIES login credentials by creating an account in the HARP system at: <a href="https://harp.cms.gov/register">https://harp.cms.gov/register</a>

3. Set up MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication) for your account and complete the Identify Proofing process.


















#### **New Security Measures**

- Requires Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)
- Identity Proofing through Experian
- Series of credit background checks
- Once a HARP account is created you can proceed to iQIES to request a role






1. Access iQIES using your HARP ID and password: <a href="https://iqies.cms.gov/">https://iqies.cms.gov/</a>

2. Initiate your Provider Security Official (PSO) role request using your provider CCN.

3. Once your request has been submitted AND approved, you will receive an email notification. At this point, you will have authority to approve/deny requests for iQIES access and role types.







































# **Deadlines by Region**

4	Region 4: AL, FL, GA, KY, MS, NC, SC, TN	Sep 23 - 2022
6	Region 6: AR, LA, NM, OK, TX	Oct 7 - 2022
5	Region 5: IL, IN, MI, MN, OH, WI	Oct 28-2022
7 and 8	Region 7: IA, KS, MO, NE	Nov.11, 2022

# SimpleLTC & PCC Authorization

Once you have established your PSO, Simple will also need to link to your account under your provider CCNs.

- As of December 1, 2022, the provider advocacy group Advion (formerly NASL) continues to work directly with CMS on the final process for linking software vendor accounts to the new iQIES. This is in coordination with Simple, PCC and other software companies.
- Simple will communicate the new process as soon as CMS makes the final decision (probably sometime in early 2023)





#### **Unknowns**

- What will happen to the old CASPER access?
- We don't know exactly what MDS submissions will look like.

- Simple has been submitting Oasis for Home Health under iQIES for a while, and the transition was a little bumpy.
- We are waiting for updates on PBJ and when the transition will occur for PBJ transmissions.





#### Removing Users & Additional Security Considerations

- How will your organization manage PSO access in the case of turnover?
- We recommend more than 1 PSO during the initial setup
- No account sharing (Remote access verification prevents this)
- PSO should manage additional Third-Party Access
